

How To Make The Retail Therapy A-Frame Board



1. Cut two of the following; A-Frame Board and A-Frame Brace.
2. Glue above the perforated line only and stick the front side to the front side.

3. Allow the glue to dry.

4. Fold thr A-Frame Board back on itself along the perforated line.

5. Insert the braces through the side slots.

How To Make The Retail Therapy Cake Stand



1. Cut one each of the following; Cake Stand, Stand Shelf (S), Stand Shelf (M), Stand Shelf (L).
2. Using the centre cut, slide Stand Shelf (L) over the top two levels down to rest on the base level.
3. Repeat with Stand Shelf (M) so that it rests on the middle level.

4. Repeat with Stand Shelf (S) and seat it on the top level.

5. To stand the cake stand up using the slot system, insert the middle leg in the back row of slots and then insert the outside legs in the front row of slots.

Top Tip: Place any elements on the shelves before assembling the Cake Stand. Alternatively you can prep the slots with a Pokey Tool.

How To Make The Retail Therapy Clothing Rail



1. Cut the following; two Clothing Rail Frames and three Bars.

2. Pinch along either side of the perforated centre of each Clothing Rail Frame to create a stiff spine.

3. Insert the bars, two into the slots in the bottom and one in the top.

4. Insert the opposite ends into the second frame piece.

Top Tip: For a free standing Rail cut another Bar and trim it to create 2 long feet, glue to the base of the end frames.

How To Make The Retail Therapy Hanging Basket Bracket



The Hanging Basket Brackets can be used individually, however for a better all round look you can create a double sided bracket.

1. Cut one each of the following; Hanging Basket Bracket 1, Hanging Basket Bracket 2, Hanging Basket Chain.
2. Glue the back of the detailed bracket up to the perforated line.
3. Stick Bracket 1 and 2 back to back and allow to dry.
4. Fold back the unglued areas, these tabs can now be used to stick to a flat surface or mounted on a corner.
5. The Hanging Basket Chain can be glued to any decorative piece using the two solid end tabs and hung on the bracket by the oval hoop end.

How To Make The Retail Therapy Swing Mirror



1. Cut once each of the following; Swing Mirror Stand (Right), Swing Mirror Stand (Left), Swing Mirror Brace, Swing Mirror.

2. Fold along the perforated lines on the Swing Mirror Stand left and right sections to create a 90 degree angle.

3. Ensure the decorated sides are facing out.

4. Apply glue to the underside of one of the folded tabs and attach to the inside of the opposite stand piece, ensuring both pieces are square and flush.

5. Insert the Swing Mirror Brace through the slots next to the top holes.

6. Introduce the Swing Mirror into the newly constructed frame, gently open the frame to allow the tabs on the mirror to feed through the frame holes.

Top Tip: If the mirror doesn't want to stand upright in its frame, add some weight to the bottom of the mirror with either a small piece of card on the back or some dabs of glue.

How To Make The Retail Therapy Tall Shelves



1. Cut the following: one Tall Shelves and three Tall Shelves Shelf.

2. Fold the centre perforated line of the Tall Shelves to create a near 90 degree angle.

3. Insert the straight edges of a Tall Shelves Shelf through the dedicated slots on either side of the Tall Shelves piece.

4. Repeat for the other 2 shelves.

5. Fold the base tabs in which ever direction will best suit your gluing needs

Top Tip: If you wish to have a free standing set of shelves you can cut a fourth shelf out and use the bottom tabs to create a base.
