

Tattered Lace DIES



RETRO ALPHABET CARD

YOU WILL NEED...

- Retro alphabet die
- Blue card
- White card
- Patterned paper
- Glue pen
- Silicone glue / glue dots
- Double sided tape
- 3D foam
- Flower and button embellishments



STEP 1

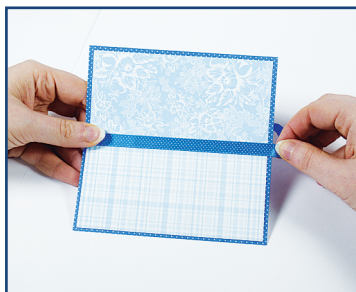
Cut the letters for Happy Birthday from blue textured paper / card.



STEP 2

Cut a piece of patterned paper to approx 5.5" x 5.5" and use double sided tape to place on a larger piece of blue card. Trim to leave a small border on each edge. Cut a second piece of co-ordinating paper to approx 5.5" x 3" and place on the bottom half of the design as shown.

STEP 3

Place a piece of ribbon across the join of the papers and secure at the back with double sided tape.



STEP 4

Use double sided tape to secure the patterned paper section to the front of a 6" x 6" white card blank.



STEP 5

Overlap two co-ordinating flower embellishments and place a button in the centre. use a glue dot or silicone glue to secure towards the top right of the card front.



STEP 6

Finish by placing the die cut Happy Birthday to the bottom left of the card. Using a striped / checked paper makes it easier to line up the letters, if you prefer you could put them at jaunty angles instead of lining them up perfectly.
