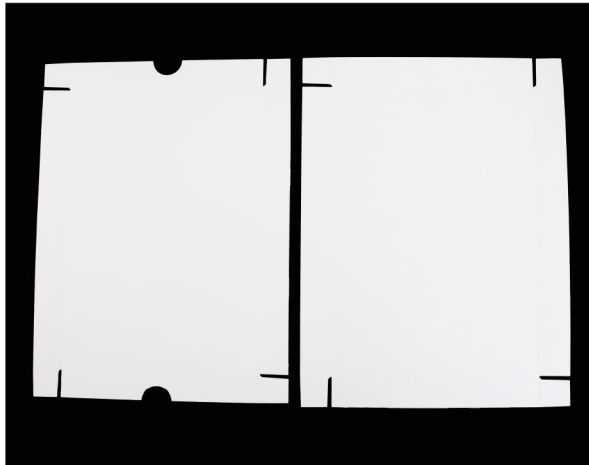

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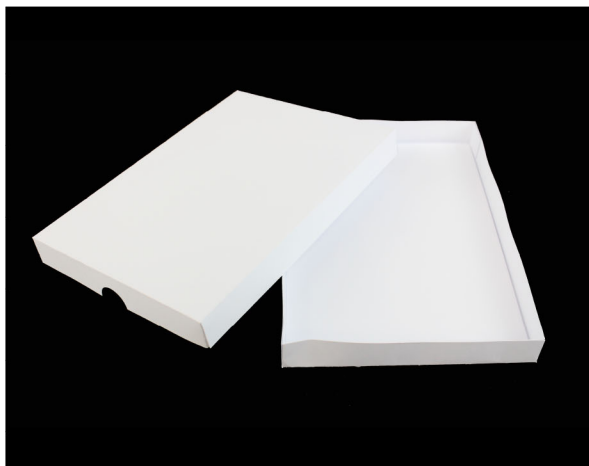
# A5 Box Lid And Base Instructions



1. Cut the box lid and box base from your chosen cardstock.



2. Mountain fold along the score lines and add tape to the tabs as shown.

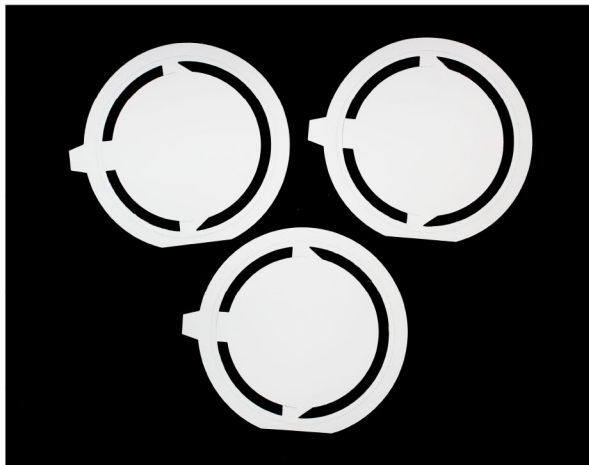


3. Mat the tabs together to create your box lid and box base.

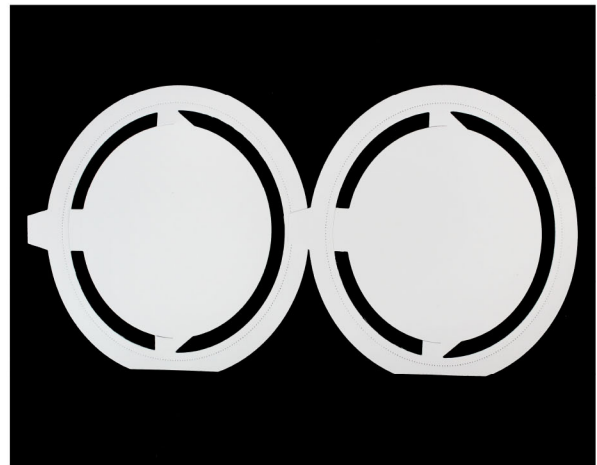


4. Repeat this process to create boxes for projects of all sizes.

## Circle, Oval, Square and Rectangle Accordion Instructions



1. Using one of the Accordion files, cut three from your chosen cardstock.



2. Mat the tab from one cut onto the edge of the second cut as shown.



3. Fold this tab to create a mountain fold. Fold the top and bottom of the centre shape on the score line. Mat the tab from one centre shape onto the other to create a valley fold.



4. Repeat this for the final piece. Cut off any excess tabs. You can continue this process to make your accordion card as big or small as you need.

# All In One Box Instructions



1. Cut the base twice from your chosen cardstock.



2. Mountain fold along the score lines, add tape to the tabs and stick together as shown.



3. Fold the box into shape and secure by sticking the tabs of the base and sides together. Ensure you fold back the top of the box when sticking the tabs together.



4. The folded back top of the box now creates a lid. Push this down to seal the box.

# Art Deco & Art Deco Linear Card Instructions

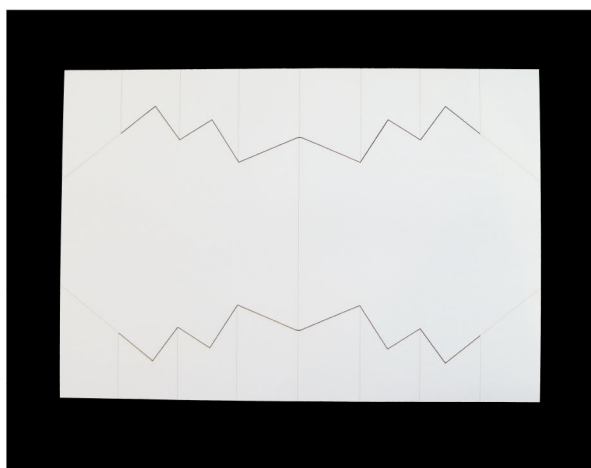


1. Cut the base from your chosen cardstock and fold in half along the score line.

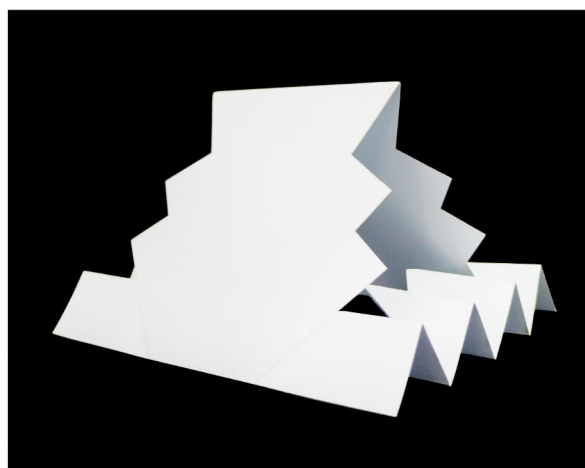


2. Using the embellishment files, cut from your chosen cardstock and mat onto the card to decorate.

# Art Deco Stepper Instructions



1. Using the Art Deco Stepper Card file, cut the card base from your chosen cardstock.

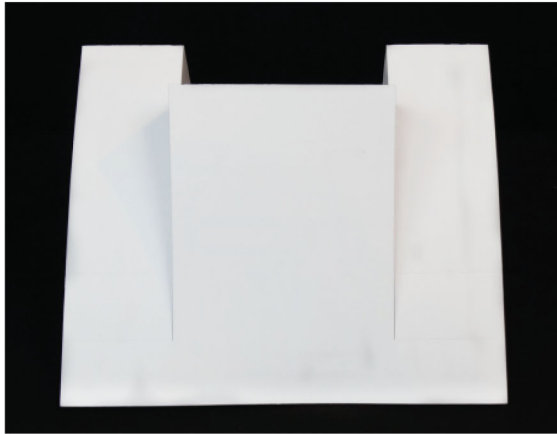


2. Fold along the score lines, starting with a mountain fold at the front and then a valley fold to create a concertina as shown.

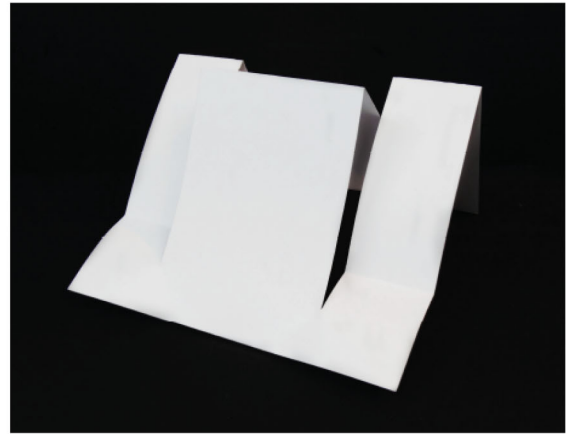


3. Using the sentiment and embellishment files, cut from your chosen cardstock and mat onto the card to decorate.

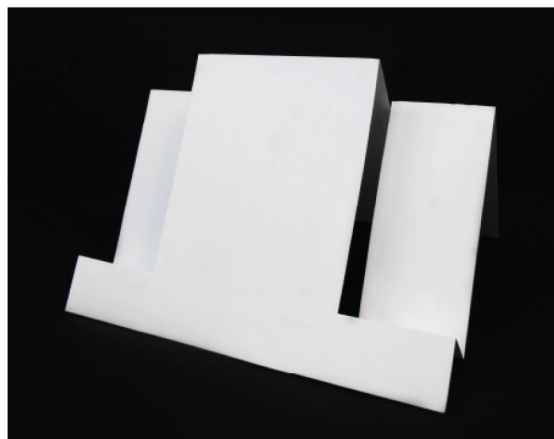
# Centre Stepper Instructions



1. Cut the file from your chosen cardstock. Mountain fold all the score lines in the centre of your cut.



2. Valley fold the next two score lines on the narrow side sections to begin creating the 'step'.



3. Mountain fold the remaining two score lines on the narrow sections to create the 'step'.

# Circle Stepper Instructions



1. Cut the file from your chosen cardstock.



2. Mountain fold along the large centre scoreline. Working from the bottom left, mountain fold the first score line. Valley fold the second. Mountain fold the third. Valley fold the fourth. Finally the last score line is a mountain fold. Burnish the folds with a bone folder.



3. Using the matting and layering files, choose from the selection and cut from your preferred cardstock.

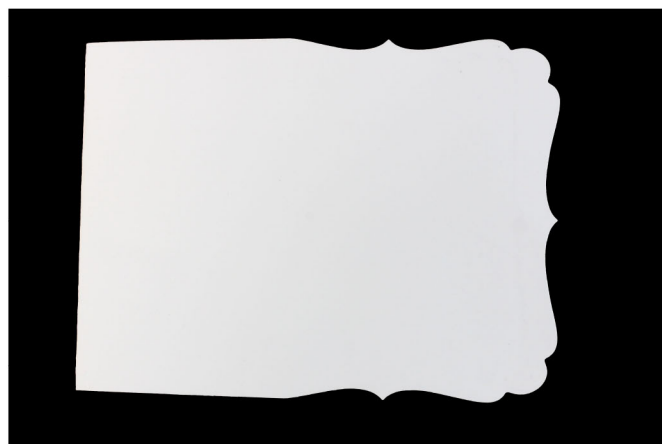


4. Decorate the card with the cuts.

# Craft a Card Instructions



1. Using the chosen Craft A Card file, cut the base from your chosen cardstock.



2. Score into your card base at your chosen point.

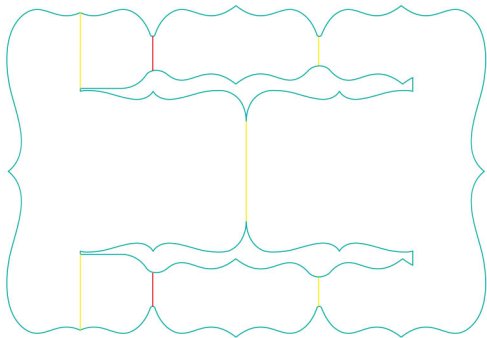


3. Using the decorative files, mix and match to decorate your card. Cut into your card front as shown to give a delicate aperture.



4. Mat and layer the decorative shapes onto the card with foam pads to finish your unique card design.

# Decorative Centre Stepper Instructions



1. Cut the file from your chosen cardstock. Mountain fold along the yellow score lines, valley fold the red score lines.



2. Your card is now ready to decorate with the matting and layering files.



3. Use the matting and layering files to decorate your cards and projects. Create stunning foliage for your card using the flower and leaf files.

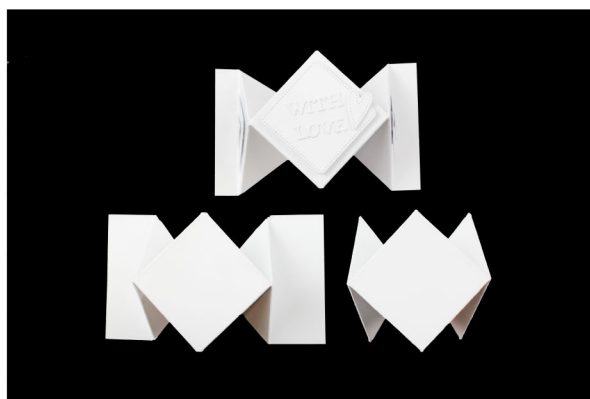
# Diamond Fold Instructions



1. Cut the Diamond Fold Card from your chosen cardstock.

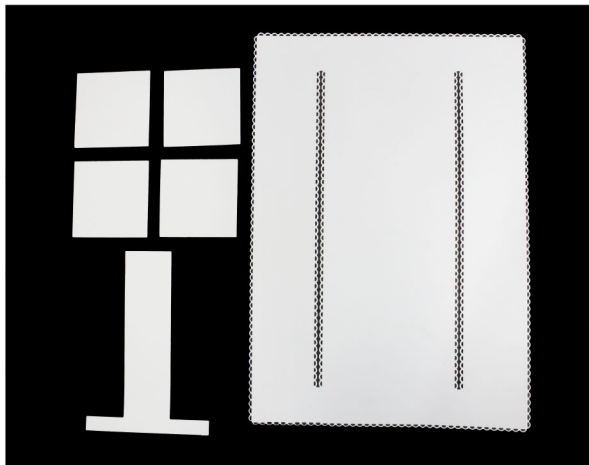


2. Fold the two vertical lines to create mountain folds, open before folding the diagonal lines into valley folds. Gently fold your card along these lines to create your diamond shape.

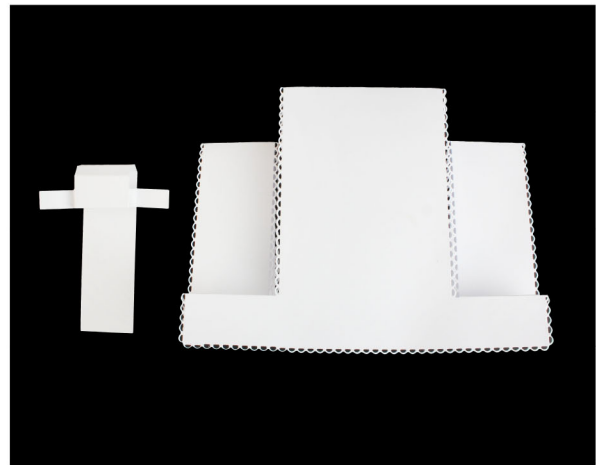


3. Decorate and embellish as required.

# Double Cascading Waterfall Instructions



1. Using the Double Cascading Waterfall file, cut the card base, the cascade mechanism and four squares from your chosen cardstock.



2. Fold the stepper card and the cascade mechanism on the score lines.

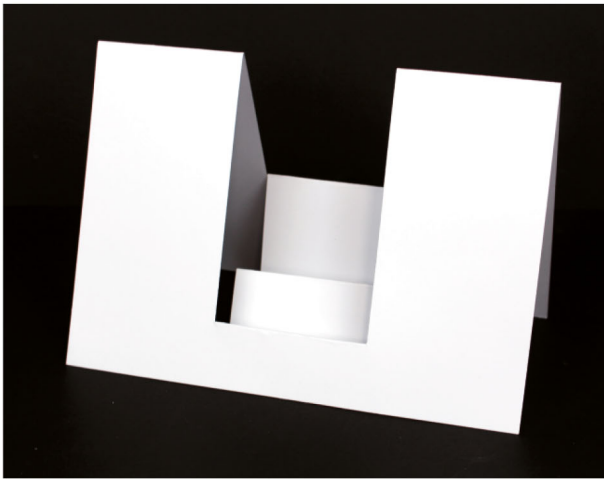


3. Apply tape to the tabs of the cascade mechanism and stick to the card so that the long part of the mechanism pulls underneath through the gap created by the tabs.

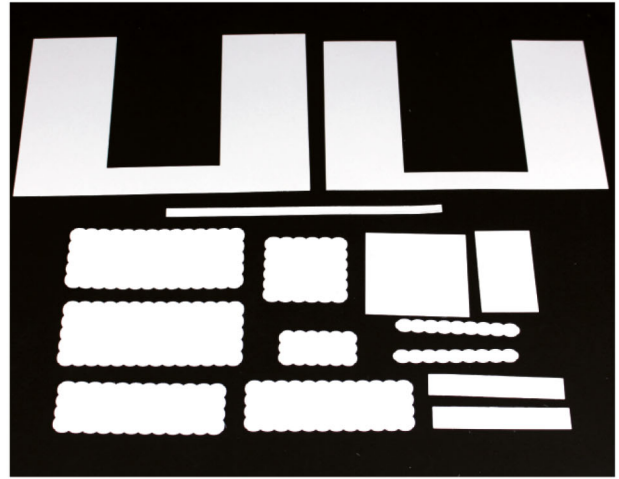


4. Attach the squares underneath each scored line. Layer these until you have all four attached with red tape.

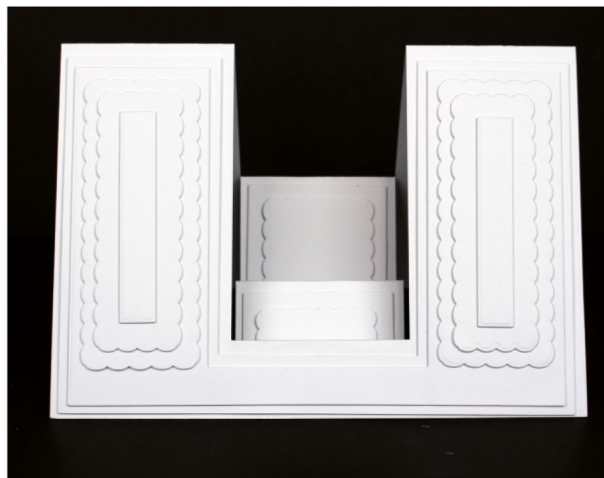
# Double Side Stepper Instructions



1. Cut the base from your chosen cardstock. Mountain fold the 2 outer score lines. The inner score lines should be folded as mountain fold, valley fold, mountain fold, valley fold, mountain fold.



2. Cut the layering pieces you wish to use to embellish your Double Side Stepper Card from your chosen cardstock.

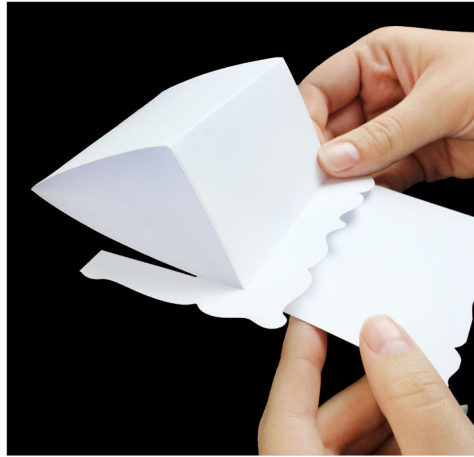


3. Decorate and embellish as required.

# Easel Slider Instructions



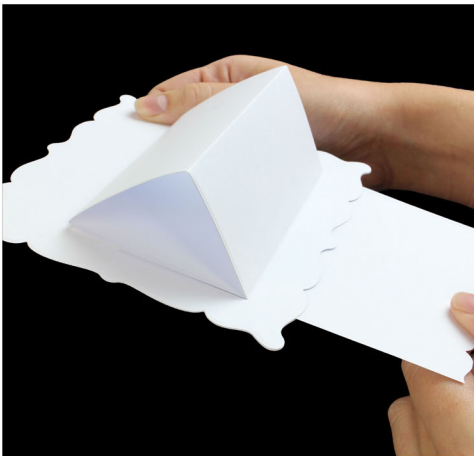
Cut easel slider base, easel slider mat 1 and easel slider mat 2 from your chosen card stock.



Fold the easel slider base on the crease lines, the fold nearest the fancy edge should be folded upwards and the second and third folds should be folded back so that the slider mechanism is now under the fancy edge.



Turn over the easel slider base and put a line of tape along the two short tabs as shown.



Peel off the tape backing to reveal the adhesive. Line up the fancy edges of the easel slider base to the fancy edges of mat 1. The slider will now slide through the gap between the attached sides.



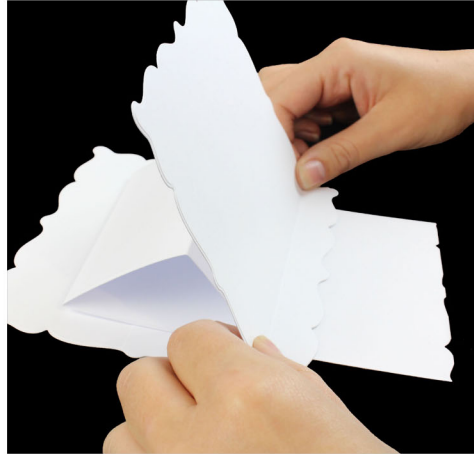
Put a line of tape on the back of easel slider mat 2 under the score line.



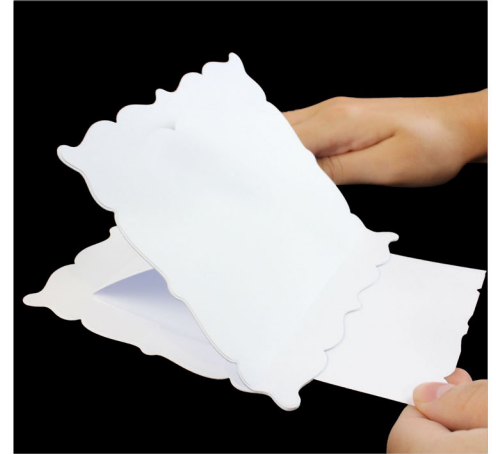
Add a little more tape centrally above the score line being careful not to put it more than half way up.



Turn over mat 2 so the front is facing you and fold upwards along the score line.

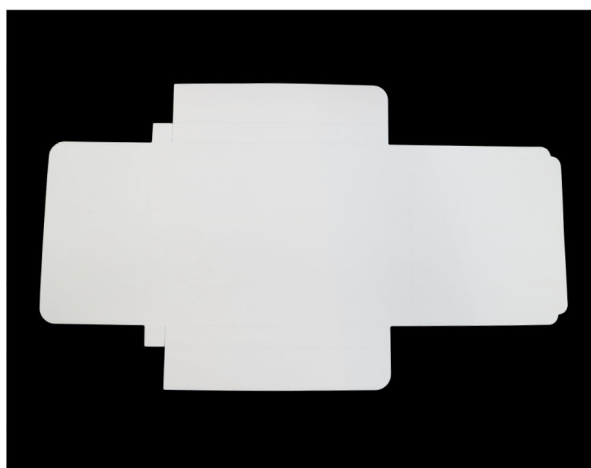


Remove the tape backing. Line up the fancy edges of mat 1 with the front of the of the easel slider base.



Your finished easel slider card should look like this.

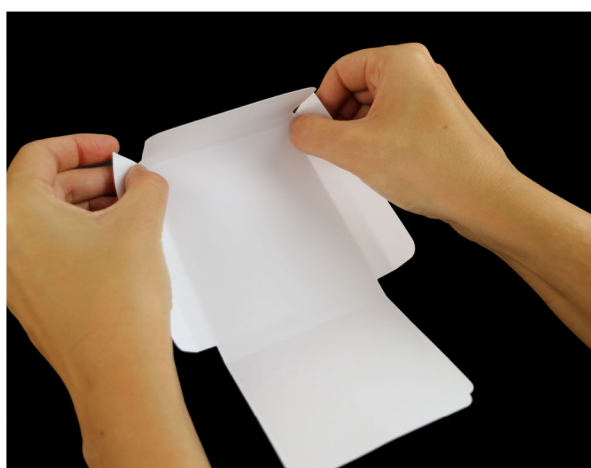
# Gift Box for Cards Instructions



1. Using the Gift Box for Card 1 file, cut from your chosen cardstock.



2. Fold along all the perforated lines as shown.

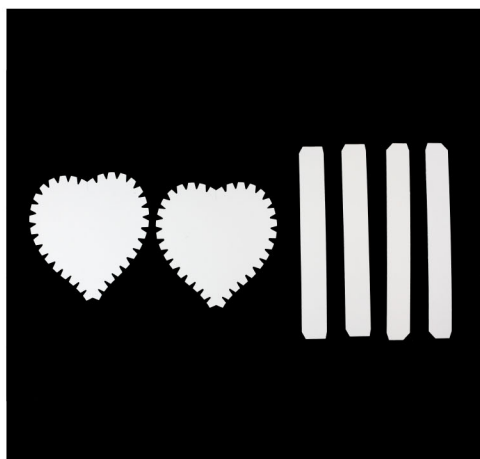


3. Mat the two small tabs onto the side of the box.

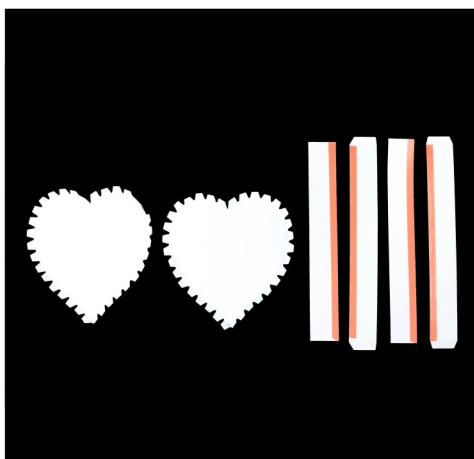


4. Fold the rest of the box into place to create a gift box.

# Heart Box Instructions



1. Cut out the base, lid, two base sides and two lid sides from your preferred cardstock.



2. Fold down all the tabs on the base and lid. Snip the tabs from one base side and one lid side. Attach red line tape to the bottom edge of all the sides and to the back of the remaining tabs.



3. Starting with the base at the centre of the top of the heart, stick the tabbed side to the lid as shown. Working on a flat surface, attach the remainder of the side to the right half of the base.



4. Attach the side to the first tab on the left half of the heart.

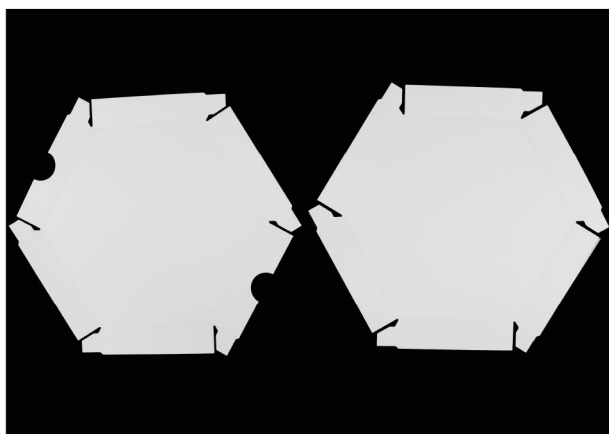


5. Using the trimmed base side, attach to the left half of the base.

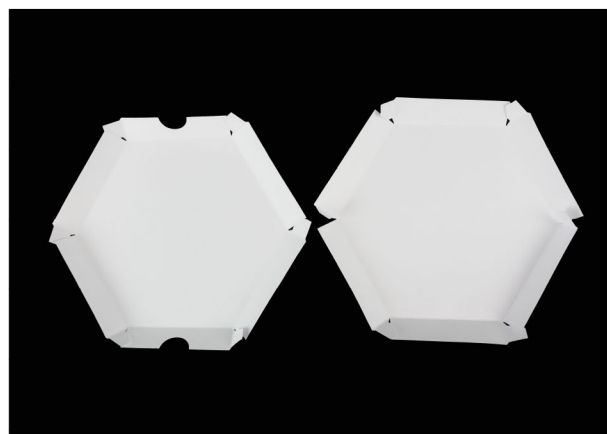


6. Repeat steps 3 to 5 for the lid.

# Hexagon Box Instructions



1. Cut your hexagon box lid and base from your chosen cardstock.



2. Mountain fold all of the score lines.



3. Use adhesive to secure each tab to the side edge of the lid or base you have cut and folded. Each tab should attach to the side it is next to.



4. Decorate your box lid and base with your chosen design.

# Holly Craft A Card Instructions



1. Using the Holly Craft A Card file, cut the base from your chosen cardstock.



2. Add as many or as little score lines as you need and fold to create your desired card shape.

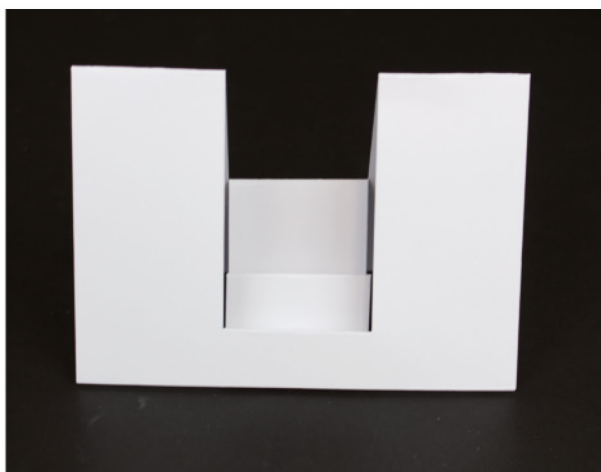


3. Using the decorative elements, mix and match to decorate your card. For example cut into your card front as shown to give a delicate aperture.

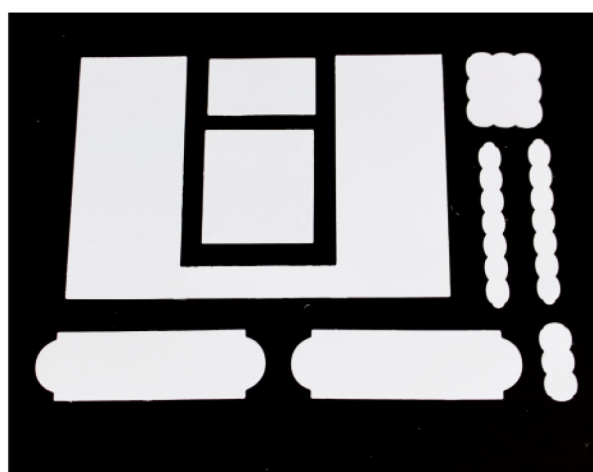


4. Mat and layer the decorative shapes onto the card with foam pads to finish your unique card design.

# Midi Double Side Stepper Instructions



1. Cut the base from your chosen cardstock. Mountain fold the 2 outer score lines. The inner score lines should be folded as mountain fold, valley fold, mountain fold, valley fold, mountain fold.



2. Cut the layering pieces you wish to use to embellish your Midi Double Side Stepper Card from your chosen cardstock.



3. Decorate and embellish as required.

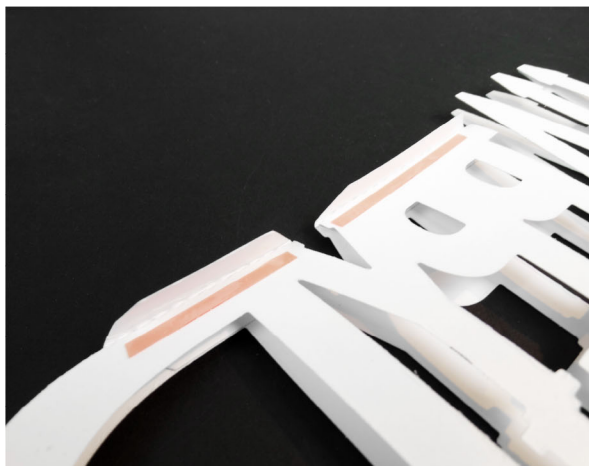
# Monumental Moments Instructions



1. Cut the file twice from your chosen cardstock.



2. Fold the flaps at the top of your first cut using the score lines so that they fold behind your letters. Fold the flaps at the top of your second die cut using the score lines so that they fold in front of your letters.



3. Place adhesive tape or glue along the outside of the flaps on your second cut and whilst matching the cut up to the top of the letters on your first cut adhere the two together. Place adhesive tape or glue on the inside of the flaps of your first cut and secure these to the back of your second cut.



4. Stand the card up so that the fold where the two pieces join is at the top and ensure that the base of the letters sits flat to the surface.

# Offset Side Stepper Instructions

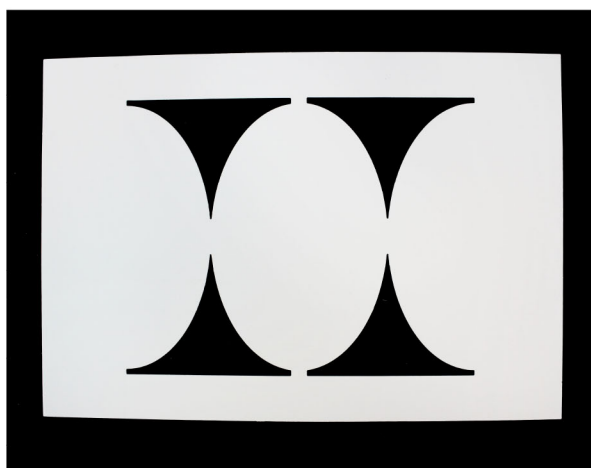


1. Using the Offset Side Stepper Card file, cut one from your chosen cardstock. Fold along the score lines with mountain and valley folds to create an Offset Side Stepper Card as shown.



2. Using your chosen Offset Side Stepper Card elements, cut from your chosen cardstock. Mat onto the card to decorate.

# Oval and Diamond Shutter Card Instructions



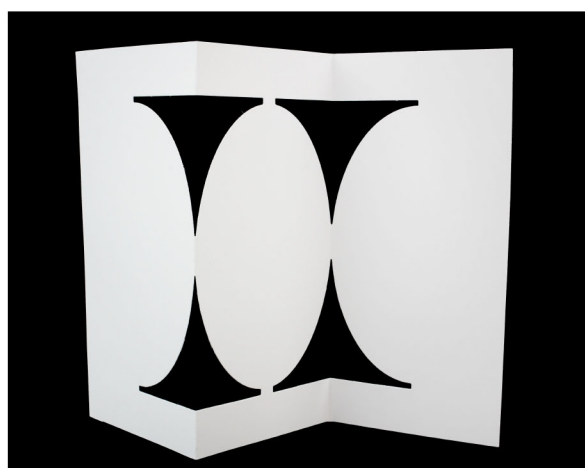
1. Cut out the Oval or Diamond Shutter Card from cardstock.



2. Starting with the left side, fold under on the second score line top, centre and bottom and burnish with a bone folder.

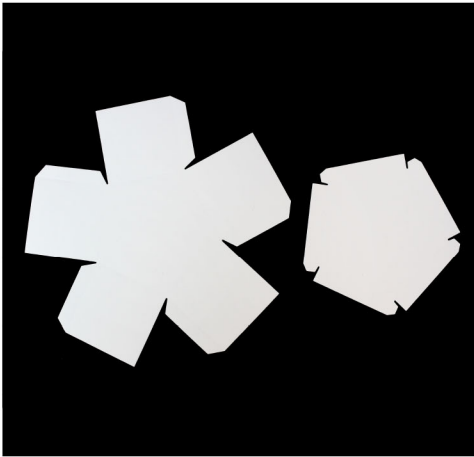


3. Working from the right side, fold up on the second line, top, centre and bottom and burnish with a bone folder.

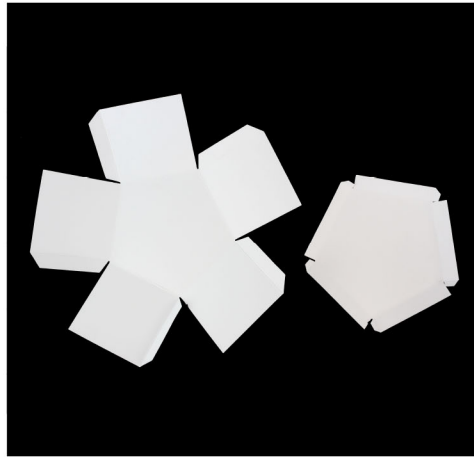


4. Fold out into place.

# Pentagon Box Instructions



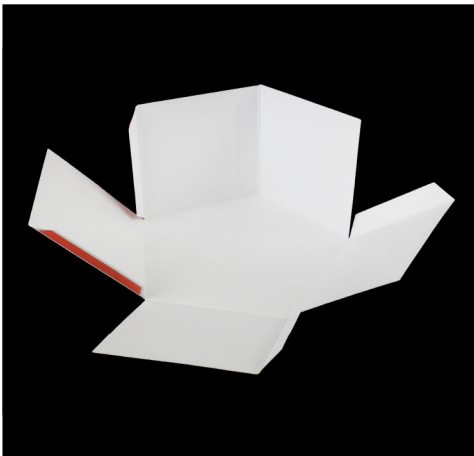
1. Cut out the box base and lid. A heavier weight of cardstock works better.



2. Fold down all the score lines.



3. Attach redline tape to all the tabs on both the base and lid.



4. Starting with the base, attach the tabs to the corresponding square until the box has been constructed.



5. Repeat step 4 for the pentagon lid.

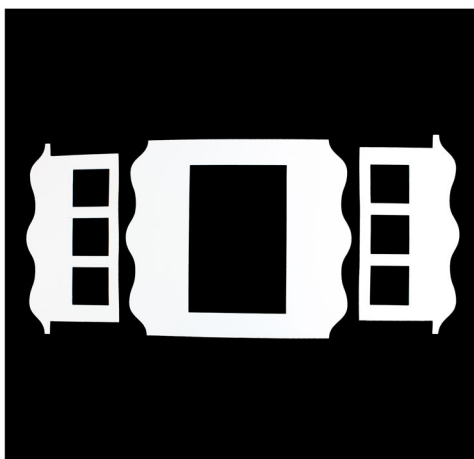


6. Fix the lid onto the box.

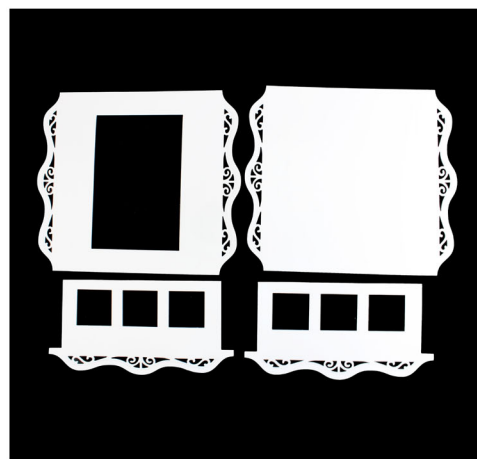
# Picture Window Instructions



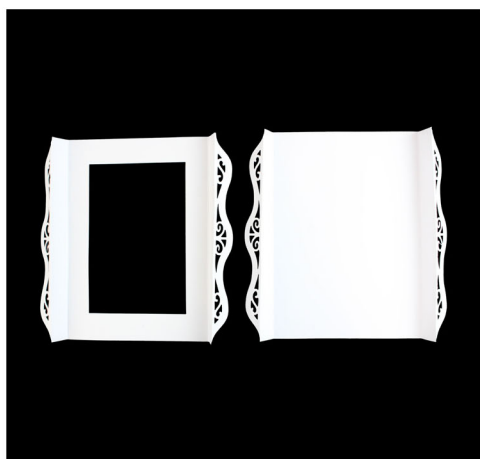
Using the picture window die, cut one front, one back and two side panels.



Using the rectangle die, cut an aperture in the centre of the front panel and cut the windows in both side panels with the square die.



Using the ornate detail, cut into all of the scalloped edges on the front, back and side panels.



Crease and fold on the score lines to make sides for the picture window card ensuring you fold the ornate detail score line outwards and the front and back scorelines inwards.

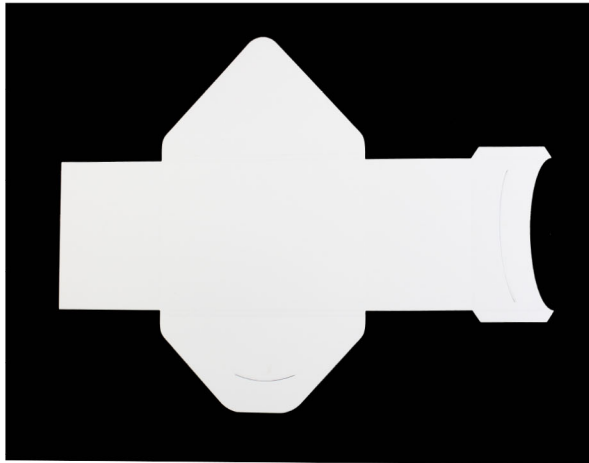


Line up and glue the scalloped edges of the side panels with those on the back panel.

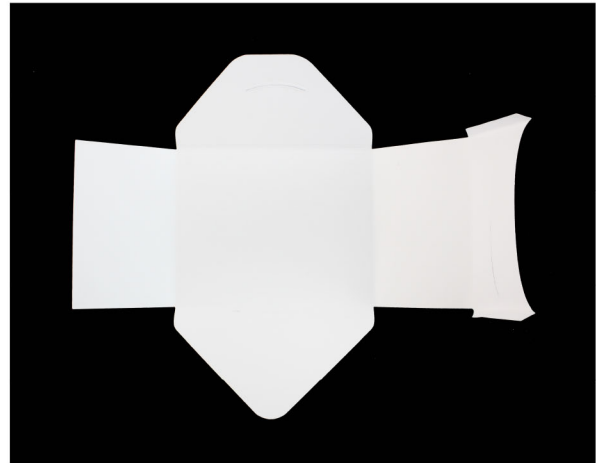


Line up and glue the scalloped edge of the front panel onto those of the side panels to complete your picture window card.

# Pocket Wrap Envelope Instructions



1. Using the Pocket Wrap Envelope 1 file and taking the small slot and curved pocket lines from the Pocket Wrap Envelope 3 file arrange them as shown above and cut.



2. Valley fold on all of the score lines as shown.

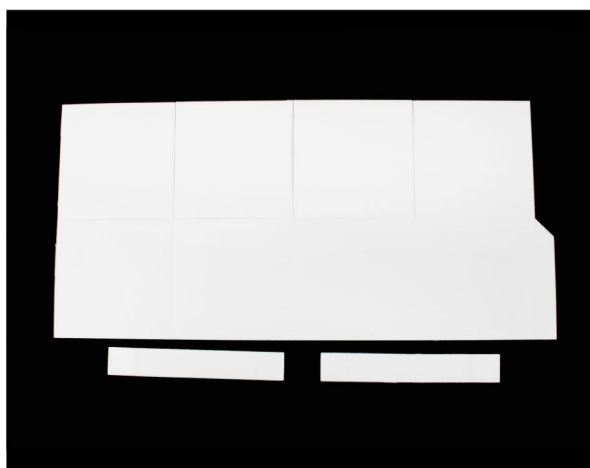


3. Add tape to the tabs on the curved pocket and mat the tabs onto the main body of the Pocket Wrap.



4. Fold all four tabs inwards and slot the top envelope tab into the bottom tab to secure.

# Pop Up Box Instructions



1. Cut the Pop Up Box 1 file and two of the perforated strips from Pop Up Box 2 file.



2. Stick double sided tape to the long tab on the base shape and on the end tabs of the two strips.

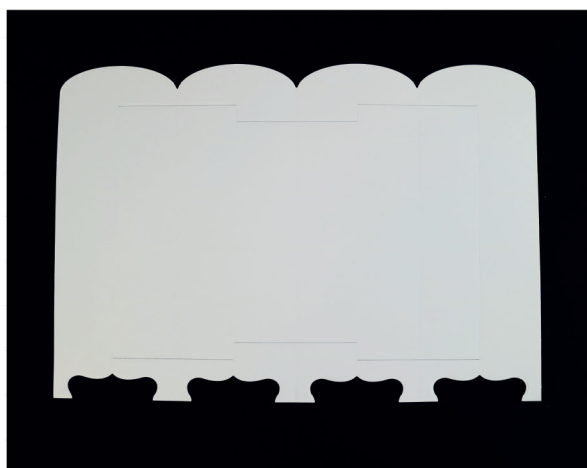


3. Fold along the perforated edges and stick the long tab to the opposite side to create your box shape.  
Note: There should be no floor to this box as it allows it to collapse flat.

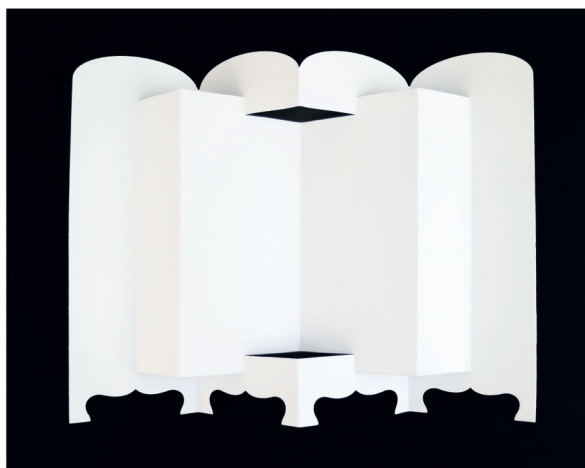


4. Finally fold the two tabs on the strips and stick across the inside of the box as shown above. These give you something to stick decorations to.

# Screen Card Instructions



1. Cut the Screen Card Base from your chosen cardstock.

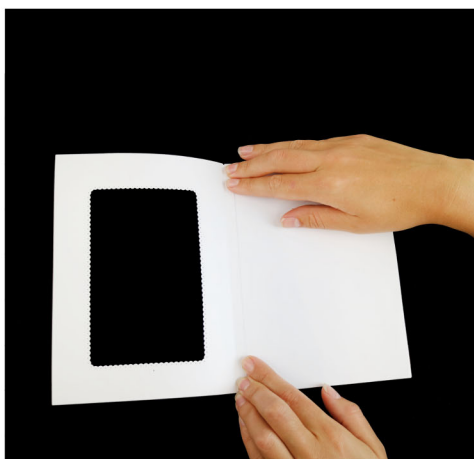


2. Fold carefully along the score lines. Starting in the middle, carefully fold the top and bottom lines in a mountain fold. The centre section should then be a valley fold. Continue folding the card in opposite directions as you work outwards to create your Screen Card.

# Secret Slider Instructions



1. Using largest frame element on file 1 cut one with and one without the aperture from your chosen cardstock. Using the largest slider element on file 3 cut three and trim away the tabs on one.



2. Trim the tab from blank frame creating the base, then mat the tab of the frame onto the base, as shown.



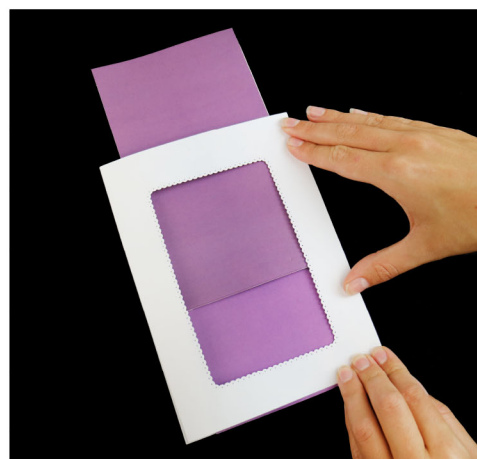
3. Using the double scored slider, fold the tabs around and mat onto base being careful to only attach the tabs to the base.



4. Using the second double scored slider, fold the tabs around and mat onto the trimmed slider to create the sliding panel.



5. Feed the double scored slider between the sliding panel pieces.



6. Mat the frame tab onto the base to secure. Use the Pull Tabs on file 1 and embellishments to complete your project.

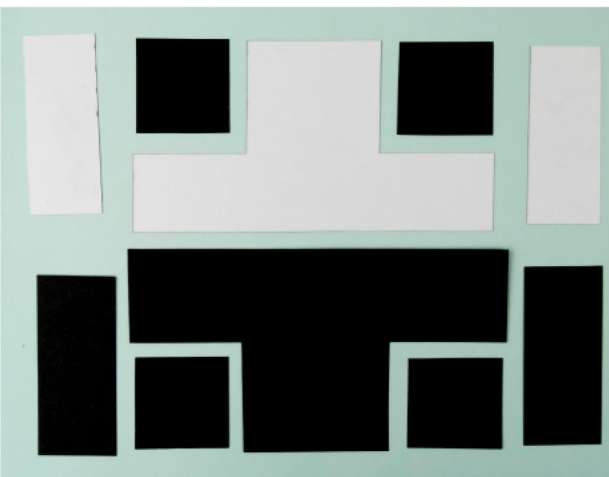
# Shutter Card Instructions



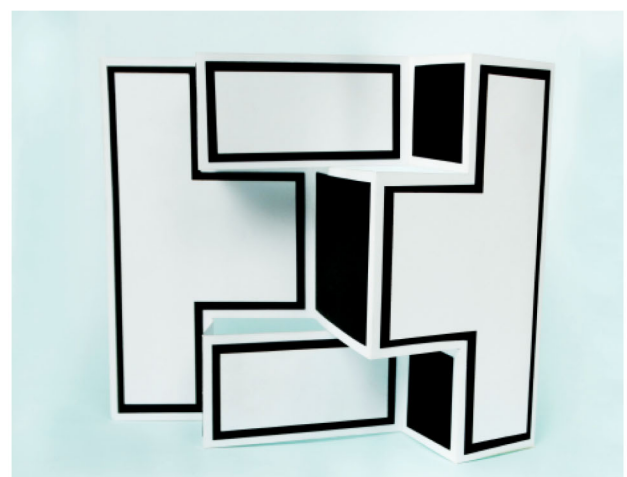
1. Cut the file from your chosen cardstock.



2. With the card in a portrait position, fold the pre-scored lines from top to bottom as follows: Line 1 – Valley, Line 2 Centre – Valley, Line 2 sides – Mountain, Line 3 Centre – Mountain, Line 3 sides – Valley, Line 4 – Mountain.



3. Using the shaped files, cut the required matting and layering shapes from co-ordinating or contrasting cardstock.

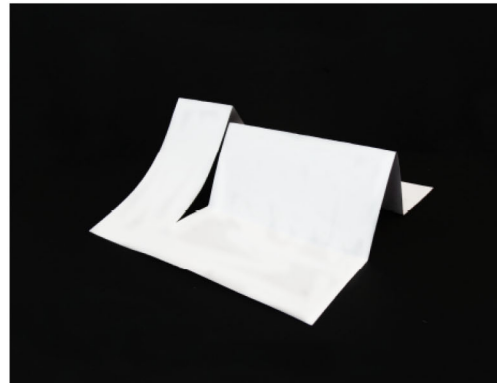


4. Secure the matting and layering shapes to the card as shown. Decorate your card as preferred.

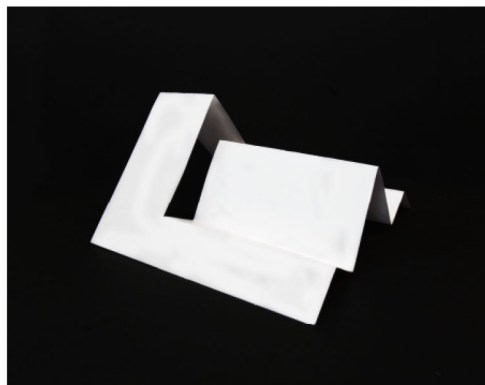
# Side Stepper Instructions



1. Cut from your chosen cardstock.  
Mountain fold along the centre score lines.

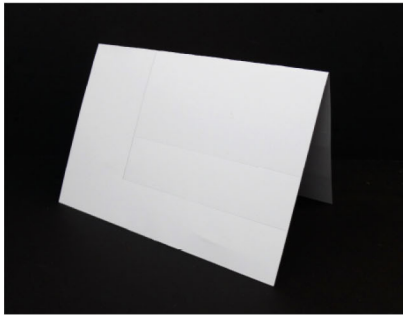


2. Valley fold both score lines either side of  
the centre.

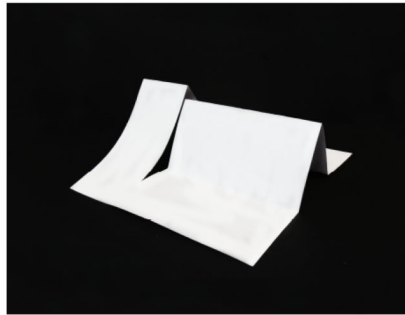


3. Finally, mountain fold the remaining score  
lines to create the Side Stepper Card.

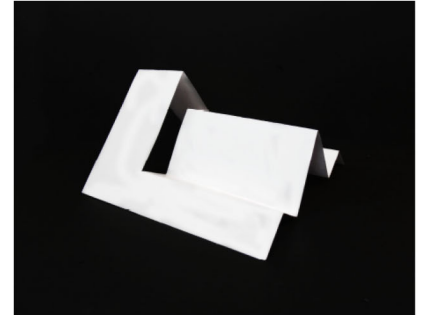
## Small Side Stepper Instructions



1. Cut from your chosen cardstock. Mountain fold along the centre score lines.



2. Valley fold both score lines either side of the centre.

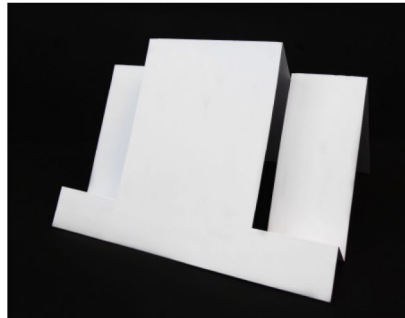


3. Finally, mountain fold the remaining score lines to create the Side Stepper Card.

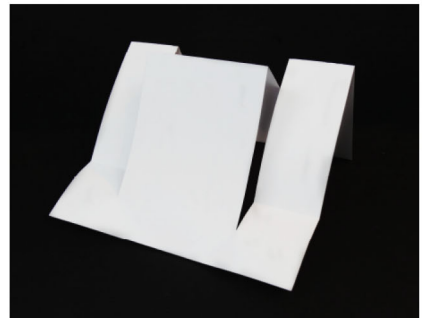
## Small Centre Stepper Instructions



1. Mountain fold all the score lines in the centre.



2. Valley fold the next two score lines on the narrow side sections to begin creating the 'step'.



3. Mountain fold the remaining two score lines on the narrow sections to create the 'step'.

# Square Box Lid And Base Instructions



1. Cut your files from your chosen cardstock.



2. Using the score lines, fold all of the edges using a mountain fold.



3. Secure the tabs on each of the corners using glue or adhesive tape to the inside of the box lid. Repeat for the base. Decorate your box and lid to your own design.

# Stage Card Instructions



1. Using the Stage Card file, cut the base from your chosen cardstock. Fold on all the score lines.



2. Slots are cut into the base of the stage as they are needed to decorate your stage card.

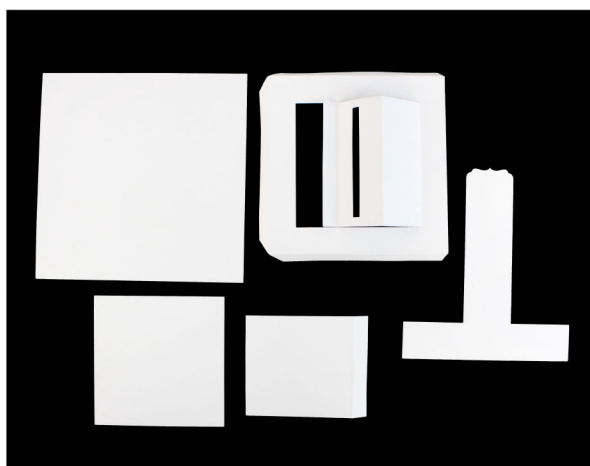


3. Fold the tabs of the stage platform to add strength and mat onto the back of the card.

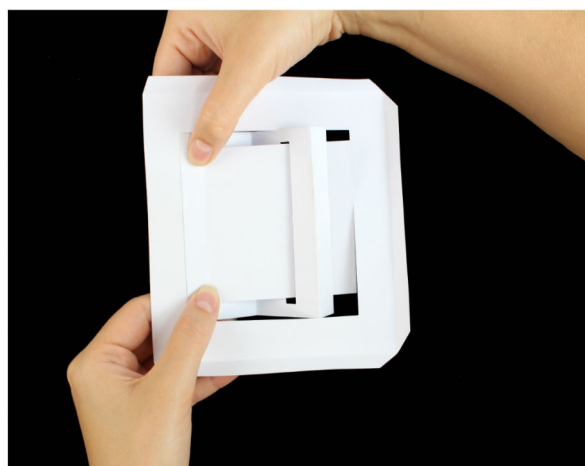


4. Push the flower power cuts through the platform slots to create a dimensional scene. Add flowers, bunting and banners to personalise.

# T Bar Slider Instructions



1. Using the T Bar Slider files, cut the T Bar, Card Base, Slider Base, Perforated Panel and Small Mat from your chosen cardstock. Fold along all the score lines.



2. Tuck the Perforated Panel through the slot in the Slider Base. Mat the tab of the Perforated panel onto the back of the Slider Base, ensuring this is lined up with the Slider Base score line.



3. Stick the T Bar onto the tab of the Slider Base, ensuring it is only stuck onto the folding centre piece and not the sides of the Slider Base.



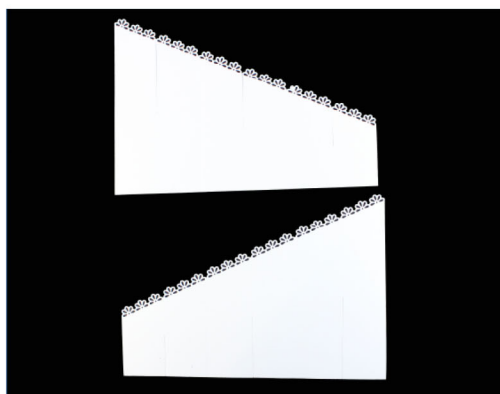
4. Using Small Mat, stick onto the front of the Slider Base to hide the Perforated panel. Mat the tabs of the Slider Base onto the Card Base to create a T Bar Slider card.

# Trifold Card Instructions



1. Using the Trifold Card 1 file, cut one from your chosen cardstock. Fold along the score lines with mountain and valley folds to create a Trifold Card as shown.

# Zig Zag Card Instructions



1. Using the Zig Zag Card 1 and 2 files cut both from your chosen cardstock.



2. Using one cut, mountain fold between two slots and valley fold between the other two. Make the opposite folds for the second cut.



3. Slide the slots from each cut together to create a Zig Zag card.



4. Decorate your card using the embellishments and mat pieces from Zig Zag Card files 3 and 4.
