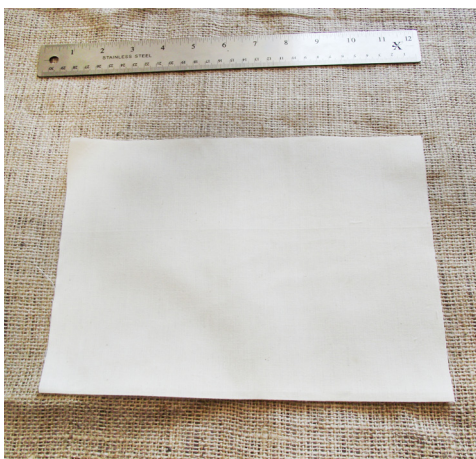


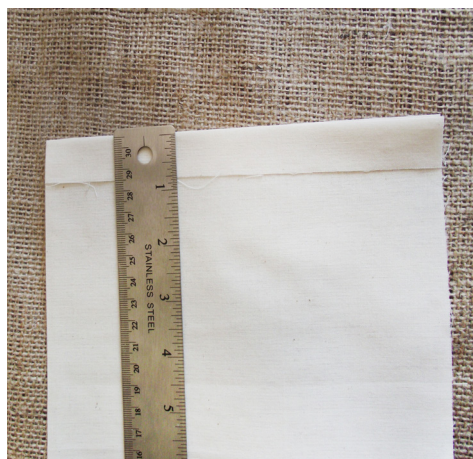
Trick or Treat Bag

What You Will Need:

- Spider Template
- Spring loaded toggle
- Elastic cord
- Black embroidery thread
- Cream cotton thread
- White cotton thread
- 2 small white buttons approx. 1/4"
- White felt
- Black felt
- Natural Calico cotton fabric
- Scissors
- Pins
- Needle



1. Cut the Calico to 15.5" x 10.5". Fold in half and iron flat.



2. Fold the top edge of the fabric to make a 3/4" seam.



3. Sew the seam close to the bottom to create a channel for the cord to be added later.

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4. Roughly cut out the spider template as shown, leaving the paper intact between the legs as this adds stability when pinning and cutting. Pin the template on to a piece of black felt.



5. Cut the spider using sharp fabric scissors. Once you remove the template, tidy the shape.



6. Cut 2 x 1.5" circles from white felt and 2 ¾" circles from black felt, using the template provided. Layer the felt circles and white buttons on the spider as shown to create the eyes. Attach the eyes by sewing all 3 layers together using white thread.



7. Sew the spider to the front of the calico fabric using black embroidery thread. Stitch around the body of the spider and also half way down the legs, leaving the lower legs free so there is some movement to it. Sew a line of stitches from the top of spider to the top of the pouch to give the impression the spider is dangling down.



8. Now either hand stitch or machine sew the side and bottom of the pouch.



9. Turn the pouch right side out and thread the cord through the channel in the top of the bag. Thread the toggle on to the cord and tie a knot in each end of the cord. Slide the toggle along the cord and then knot both ends of the cord together to secure in place.
